

DEBATE COMPETITION

1.) Eligibility Criteria

Participation is restricted to the bonafide – registered students of the ICSI. Students will be required to carry their Identity Cards of ICSI with them at the competition.

Practicing Advocates, Chartered Accountants, Cost Accountants are not eligible to participate

and the students of ICSI who have cleared all modules of Professional Programme are not eligible to participate.

2.) Time Limit

Students have the option to speak either “for the motion” or “against the motion”.

Each participant will be given a time limit not exceeding 05 minutes to speak on the subject.

A warning bell will be given after 03 minutes and a final bell after 04 minutes. If the participants exceed the allocated time than the marks will be deducted at the discretion of the judges.
