A series of functions were organized by the Hyderabad Chapter throughout the day, including Professional Development Programme, Interaction with the President, a Pooja at the Center of Excellence premises.

Professional Development Programmes

From 26th January to the ensuing June month, SIRC has organized 24 Professional Development Programmes, wherein more than 50 speakers have shared their knowledge. What is unique is that all the 50 speakers have been different and no speaker has been repeated. We are trying to introduce as many new speakers as possible and at the same time requesting already established stalwarts to interact with our members in these programmes.

The first in the series was a Workshop on GST Annual return, which was attended by more than 70 participants. Even though it was not a Company law topic and was held on a working day evening, this good attendance motivates us to continue with this new initiative. This month we have planned some interesting programmes including a seminar on Drafting and Vetting of Contracts and Latest changes by MCA in the last six months.
