➤ **Instructions to the participants:**

- a) One student monitor (for whole event) will be decided by the concerned RO/Chapter.
- b) Smoking and drinking are strictly prohibited.

➤ **Dress Code:**

- a) Day - 1 (11th January 2026): students should come in dress appropriate to the requirements of his or competition, or in office wearing.
- b) Day - 2 in morning march: white or off-white Shirt / T-Shirt / Top

Note: after marching, you can change the dress if you want to change.

- Any special materials, things, equipment etc. required by you for taking part in your competition or required for performance, should be brought by you.
- Please carry your ICSI identity Card OR any other identity such as Driving License, Aadhar Card, PAN Card, Passport, etc.
- Avoid wearing revealing clothes, shorts, half pants, Bermudas during activities at venue.
- Please adhere to meal timings & competition timings to be conveyed to you in due course by concerned Regional/Chapter Office. Timetable should be strictly adhered to and followed without any excuse; else you can be debarred from taking part in any of the activities. (The final decision will rest with the ICSI).

Registration process:

a} Regions/Chapters

Please ensure that you complete your registration at concerned Regional/Chapter Office as per schedule conveyed by them. The respective coordinator of your Region/Chapter will provide you lanyard/badge/Lunch Coupon once your registration is done.

➤ General Safety, Health and Hygiene

Follow instructions from event organizers and volunteers at all times.

- **First Aid:** *A first aid station will be available at the venue. In case of medical emergencies, please approach the nearest volunteer or staff member.*
- **Hydration:** *Carry a water bottle to stay hydrated, be sure to use the water stations available at the venue.*
- **Rest and Breaks:** *Take regular breaks to avoid exhaustion. If you feel unwell or dizzy,*
- Please rest at a designated area and seek assistance if needed.

➤ Conduct and Behavior:

EVENT SPECIFIC RULES / PROCESS (General Rules)

1. BUSINESS IDEA: 2 MINUTE MEIN
 - a) Contestants have to speak about a business idea which takes care of all aspects – planet, people and profit in order to create a sustainable business.
 - b) Contestant can show videos/ snap shots/ images by way of PowerPoint or otherwise during pitching session along with their speech. No additional time will be provided for this.
 - c) Carrying of reading paper will not be allowed.
 - d) Language of Presentation: English
 - e) Enough research is required to present a good idea matching all the three aspects. Substitutes of existing products including plastic or changes in the existing business models (how things are done) are indicative examples. Innovative products, services, ideas will be required.
 - f) Time for each contestant –Minimum – 1 Minute & Maximum 2 mins. (Reminder at 1.5 mins.) – refer Elevator Pitching Sessions.

- g) Negative marking for exceeding time limit.
- h) Order of speaking will be chosen by way of draw of lots.
- i) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- j) Other rules will be informed on spot.
- k) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- l) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

2. POETRY COMPETITION

- a) Participants have to speak their own poetry
- b) Language – English/Hindi
- c) Time- Minimum- 1 Minute & Maximum 5 minutes
- d) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- e) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- f) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

3. LEGAL PUZZLE: ULTA PULTA

- a) Quiz will be conducted based on jumble phrases and their meanings, crossword etc.
- b) The Competition shall be in MCQ Pattern.
- c) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize (all Team Prizes)
- d) Language – English
- e) Time- Minimum- 10 Minutes & Maximum 20 minutes
- f) 25 Questions
- g) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- h) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

4. BEST OUT OF WASTE

- a) Contestants have to use their own art materials (anything as per their creativity – scrap, colours, colored papers, ribbon, decorative materials etc.) and chart paper of standard size and also their tools like scissors, glue, cello tape etc. They will also have to use waste materials like used plastic bottles or any other waste materials.
- b) Their artwork can be of any form or description, and it has to be done on a chart paper.
- c) The creativity will be on creating the best artwork using the waste materials along with other materials as indicated above.
- d) Copying from any source is prohibited. Original thoughts are encouraged.
- e) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- f) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- g) Time- Minimum- 15 Minutes & Maximum 30 minutes
- h) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

5. SLOGAN WRITING COMPETITION

- a) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize (all Team Prizes)
- b) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- c) Language: Hindi/English
- d) Time- Minimum- 5 Minute & Maximum 15 minutes
- e) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding

6. SONGS COMPETITION (SOLO PERFORMANCE): HAR DIL KI PUKAAR (In any Indian Language)

- a) Time to each singer – Minimum – 2 Minutes & 5 minutes maximum
- b) Negative marking for exceeding time limit
- c) Award Categories: 1st Prize (Male and Female separately)
- d) Musical instruments can also be used during singing.
- e) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- f) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

7. KNOW YOUR STATE

- a) KNOW YOUR STATE -Quiz will be conducted in MCQ Pattern.
- b) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize (all Team Prizes)
- c) Language – English
- d) Time- Minimum- 10 Minutes & Maximum 20 minutes
- e) 25 Questions
- f) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- g) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.
- h) Other rules will be informed on spot.

8. ELOCUTION: BOL BINDAAS

- a) Each contestant has to recite (without looking at the text) any part of the Historic speech given by Swamiji at the Parliament of Religion, Chicago in the year 1893.
- b) Marks will be cut for breaks, mistakes of any kind /manner
- c) Prompting / reading will not be allowed.
- d) Candidates may dress in the attire of Swamiji
- e) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- f) Rules may change. Please keep track.

- g) Time to each speaker – Minimum- 1 Minute & 5 minutes maximum
- h) Languages allowed - English
- i) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- j) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding

9. GROUP DANCE: PAYAL KI JHANKAR

- a) Minimum two and maximum five contestants can be nominated who will participate jointly.
- b) Props and costumes can be used
- c) Minimum: 2 Minutes & Maximum time per team – 5 minutes.
- d) Language: Hindi/English/Regional Language
- e) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize (all Team Prizes)
- f) Rules will be updated from time to time. Please keep track.
- g) Decision of Judge(s) / Organising Committee shall be final and binding.

10. RANGOLI

- a) Contestants have to use their own art materials (anything as per their creativity –colours, colored papers, decorative materials etc.)
- b) Their artwork can be of any form or description.
- c) The creativity will be on creating the best artwork
- d) Award Categories: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
