so warrant, permit the withdrawal, at any stage, including before or after registration of the complaint.

Provided that in case the Director has not yet formed his prima-facie opinion on such a complaint, he shall place the same before the Board of Discipline, and the Board of Discipline may, if it is of the view that the circumstances so warrant, permit the withdrawal".

- 4. The Director (Discipline) had formed his *prima-facie* opinion in the matter.
- 5. The Disciplinary Committee considered the letter received from the Complainant requesting for withdrawal of the complaint vis-a-vis the provisions of the Company Secretaries Act, 1980 and the Company Secretaries (Procedure of Investigations of Professional and Other Misconduct and Conduct of Cases) Rules, 2007 governing withdrawal of a complaint; permitted withdrawal of the complaint and closed the matter.

Accordingly, the complaint stands disposed-off.
