

so warrant, permit the withdrawal, at any stage, including before or after registration of the complaint.

Provided that in case the Director has not yet formed his *prima-facie* opinion on such a complaint, he shall place the same before the Board of Discipline, and the Board of Discipline may, if it is of the view that the circumstances so warrant, permit the withdrawal".


4. The Director (Discipline) had formed his *prima-facie* opinion in the matter.
5. The Disciplinary Committee considered the letter received from the Complainant requesting for withdrawal of the complaint *vis-a-vis* the provisions of the Company Secretaries Act, 1980 and the Company Secretaries (Procedure of Investigations of Professional and Other Misconduct and Conduct of Cases) Rules, 2007 governing withdrawal of a complaint; permitted withdrawal of the complaint and closed the matter.

Accordingly, the complaint stands disposed-off.
