
ORDER

1. The appellant has filed first appeal dated 3rd April, 2017 (received in this office on 10th April, 2017) under section 19 (1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 against the response issued vide letter dated 28th February, 2017 by the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO) (hereinafter referred to Respondent) of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India.
2. In this appeal, the appellant has requested for providing various information in respect of direct recruitment examination for the post of Executive (Admin) conducted by the Institute on 25th December, 2016.
3. The respondent vide letter dated 28th February, 2017 had informed the appellant that the information as sought by the appellant was not as per Clause (f) of Section 2 of the Right to Information Act, 2005.
4. This Office has noted that opportunity was given to the Appellant to be present in this Office at ICSI House, C-37, Sector-62, Noida – 201 309(UP) on 16th March, 2017 in order to enable proper appreciation of facts and figures. The representative of the Appellant appeared on the said date and presented the views of the appellant.



5. The respondent has further informed that the RTI Act, 2005 does not make it obligatory on the part of the Public Authority to create information and the information which is not in existence can not therefore be created and provided.
6. This Office has carefully considered the application, the response, the appeal, the records made available and finds that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record.
7. After reviewing all the available information and facts, this Office concurs with the submission of the respondent that the information sought by the appellant is not an information under Section 2(f) of the RTI Act.

The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
