
**ORDER**

1. The Appellant has filed first appeal dated 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 (received in this office on 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2017) under section 19(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 against information provided vide letter Ref.No. RTI 2005/1925(17) dated 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 by the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO) (hereinafter referred to as Respondent) of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India.
2. In this appeal, the Appellant has requested for providing detailed Income & Expenditure of Investor Awareness Programmes held during the period from 19.01.2014 to 18.01.2015 at EIRC.
3. The Respondent has submitted that details Accounts of Receipt and Payment Account of IAP (Investor Awareness Programme) held during the period from 19.01.2014 to 18.01.2015 (when Ms. Sunita Mohanty was Vice Chairman of EIRC) at EIRC has been provided to the appellant.
4. The Respondent has further submitted that copies of individual report submitted to the office of Ministry of Corporate Affairs are not preserved once the same has been approved by Ministry of Corporate Affairs.
5. The Respondent has further informed that the information as sought by the Appellant has already been provided and he may seek any further information not covered under the original RTI query by submitting a fresh request.



6. This Office has carefully considered the application, the response, the appeal and the records made available and finds that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record.
7. This Office concurs with the submission of the Respondent that the information as sought by the Appellant has already been provided and the appellant may seek additional information by submitting a fresh request.

The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
